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ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids will be received by the City of St. Clairsville, 100 North Market Street, St. Clairsville, Ohio 43950 until 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 16, 2018 for the New Reservoir Improvement Project, as set forth in Bidding Documents. At said time and place, bids will be publicly opened and read aloud for the following work:

City of St. Clairsville - New Reservoir Improvement Project

Contract A: New Waterline Utility Tank

Base Bid: Labor, material and equipment to install a 0.5 million gallon pre-stressed concrete water utility storage tank.

Alternate #1: Labor, material and equipment to install a 0.5 million gallon steel, glass lined water utility storage tank. Contractor will be responsible for the design and construction of a retaining wall to allow for installation of steel, glass lined water utility storage tank.

Contract B: Booster pump station, yard piping, site improvements, and all electrical at the proposed storage tank site.

Contract C: Demolition of existing elevated multi-leg steel water utility storage tank, and relocation of the communication antennas from the multi-leg tank to the existing spherical tank at the same site.

Bidding Documents can be seen at the Municipal Building, 100 North Market Street, St. Clairsville, Ohio 43950 and at office of the Engineer, W.E. Quicksall and Associates, Inc, 554 West High Avenue New Philadelphia, Ohio 44663. Bidding Documents may be obtained at the Office of the Engineer upon payment of \$150.00 plus any associated shipping costs. Checks should be made payable to the W.E. Quicksall and Associates, Inc. Bidding Documents are not returnable for a refund. In addition, Bidding Documents will also be on file with the plan room of F.W. Dodge Corp. and Builders Exchange.

Bidders who submit a Bid must be a Plan Holder of record at the Issuing Office. Bids from Bidders who are not on the Plan Holders List may be returned as not being responsive.

DOMESTIC STEEL USE REQUIREMENTS AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 153.011 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE APPLY TO THIS PROJECT. COPIES OF SECTION 153.011 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE CAN BE OBTAINED FROM ANY OF THE OFFICES OF THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES.

Attention of bidders is called to all of the requirements contained in the bid packet, particularly to the Federal Labor Standards Provisions and Davis-Bacon wages, various insurance requirements, various equal opportunity provisions, and the requirement for a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond for 100% of the contract price.

Bids shall be subject to the condition that the right is reserved to hold bids for a period not longer than 60 days after date of opening and/or to award at any time during the period.

The CITY reserves the right to reject any and all bids, or to increase, to decrease or omit any item or items and/or to award to the lowest and responsible, responsive, bidder. The City also reserves the right to waive any informalities or irregularities in the Bid received.
