Outdoor Warning Siren Activation Guidelines

Outdoor Warning Siren(s) shall be activated under the following criteria by either St. Clairsville Police Department or Cumberland Trail Fire District:

- 1. Tornado Warning issued by the National Weather Service (NWS), naming the City of St. Clairsville in which the siren is located.
- 2. Tornado or Funnel cloud observed by public safety personnel with imminent threat to the City of St. Clairsville in which the siren is located.
- Request of activation by the Police or Fire Chief or the Belmont County Emergency Management Coordinator <u>ONLY</u>.
- 4. Severe Thunderstorm Warning issued by the NWS for the specific community in which the siren is located, <u>AND</u> forecasted or verified conditions of 70 mph winds or greater, or half-dollar size (1.25") hail or greater.
- 5. Testing will be 1st Monday of each month at 12:00 Noon.
- 6. Sirens should be sounded for 3 to 5 minutes, re-sounding for the duration of the threat every 10-15 minutes is recommended.
- 7. There will be NO all clear signal from outdoor warning sirens.
