**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2019 - 11**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2019 - 07  
AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE  
DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICES TO SOLICIT  
COMPETITIVE BIDS FOR THE RESURFACING OF  
STREETS IN THE CITY OF ST. CLAIRSVILLE  
AND AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE  
NOT TO EXCEED \$200,000.00 FOR THE CALENDAR  
YEAR 2019 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the City has determined that various streets have fallen into a state of disrepair and need to be resurfaced; and

**WHEREAS**, the resurfacing of various City streets will improve the public peace, health, and welfare of the residents of the City of St. Clairsville.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CLAIRSVILLE, OHIO:**

**Section 1:** That Ordinance Number 2019 - 07 is hereby amended to allow the Director of Public Services for the City of St. Clairsville to be authorized and directed to accept lowest bids for the resurfacing of various City streets in the City of St. Clairsville, and to accept the lowest and best bid for the resurfacing and to authorize work for such resurfacing not to exceed \$200,000.00 for the calendar year 2019.

**Section 2:** That the Director of Public Services is authorized to spend funds for the resurfacing of various City streets upon award of a contract.

**Section 3:** That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety of the residents of the City of St. Clairsville and for further reasons that delays in the resurfacing of the City streets will adversely affect the safety interests of the residents of the City of St. Clairsville and the financial interest of


the City.

**Section 4:** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by the Charter of the City of St. Clairsville, Ohio.


